7. Transponders

Each competitor must have a transponder fitted to their kart as per rule 19.17 (a) & (b). Transponders must be fitted as per rule 25.30.

8. Minimum Entries

The minimum number of entries per class shall be 6. If insufficient entries are received for a class, classes may be cancelled or combined at the discretion of the Organiser.

9. Format of Racing

Three heats of 10 laps Computer draw for grid position. Pre final of 15 Laps Kart with lowest point score to grid 1. Final of 18 laps finishing position of pre final determines grid position in final. Winner of final shall be declared winner of the event.

Overall Junior Champion and Senior Champion will be driver with highest point score determined by number of entries in class, if draw, Rule 19.21 will apply
